We are a multi-professional team of homeless specialists including 2 GPs, general and psychiatric nurses, housing support workers, an occupational therapist and a social worker.

- Provide advice about homelessness, homeless health and housing law
- Spend time with patients and provide TV cards, clothing and canteen tokens
- Provide skilled advocacy for patients at homeless persons units
- Work across primary and secondary care boundaries to ensure needs in the community are met
- Use existing links with homeless services across Westminster, Southwark, Lambeth and Lewisham in order to meet client needs
- Assist in-patient teams to attempt to reduce the high rates of self-discharge and re-attendance in this client group
